What is the Project Sponsor Portal (PSP)?

The PSP provides a consolidated location for accessing SRBC regulated and registered water use related web platforms including the Monitoring Data Website (MDW), Online Applications, the Susquehanna Water Use Network, and Project Contact Information (PCI). You will use this universal login to report water usage, print invoices, submit and access applications, chart water use, and much more. There is no longer a need to login to multiple platforms. Previous individual platform links will redirect to the PSP or will be removed from our website.

How do I access the PSP?

Approved water users will use their current individual MDW username and password to login. First-time applicants will use their initial application username and password, however, they will only have online application access, and all PSP features will not be available until an application is approved. Similarly, consultants with shared-access accounts can also login to the PSP, but will only be able to access the associated application. After logging into the PSP, a list of web platforms will be available based on access permissions. For instance, if a user currently has access to MDW, then MDW and related links will be available. A project sponsor primary facility contact will have the ability to assign access permissions for different web platforms, access the PCI Master Form, and update data entry contact information through the “Manage User Access” section of the PSP.

What is the Susquehanna Water Use Network (Susquehanna WUN)?

The Susquehanna WUN displays SRBC and state regulatory agency water use permit and/or registration information together on one page in a dashboard format. This website allows for the comparison of all known water use permits or registrations for a given facility and associated source(s) regardless of the permitting agency. Charting functionality provides the ability to track and analyze reported water use trends.

The website is secure and intended for SRBC and state regulatory agency staff, as well as regulated or registered project sponsors. Susquehanna WUN supports more accurate water resource management activities and promotes data sharing between SRBC and state regulatory agencies. Note: Project sponsors will only be able to view information on their own water use permits or registrations.

What else do I need to know to get started?

The PSP, including Susquehanna WUN, is available to project sponsors and state regulatory agency staff only. It is not available to the general public. Public information on regulated projects can be found on our [Water Application and Approval Viewer \(WAAV\)](#).
